Article 4. Voting rules

1. Any decisions made by the statutory EUPOS bodies that consist of more than one member are discussed in the open forum of that particular body and then voted upon by all its members. The discussion can take place on-site or via e-mail forum.
2. Any personal decisions or elections are to be conducted in a secret vote (anonymous vote). The vote can take place on-site during the Council Meeting or in cases of less than $50 \%$ of all member attendance on-site during the Council meeting as a remote e-voting.
3. If not specified otherwise, the normal voting procedure requires absolute simple majority $(50 \%+1$ | of all eligible votes) to be accepted.
4. In case of changes in Terms of Reference, an absolute $67 \%$ majority is required. If the number of the voting is lower than $67 \%$ of all Members, but not less than $50 \%$, a unanimous agreement of all the voting Members is required for a valid vote
5. In case of elections to the EUPOS statutory bodies, the voting shall be conducted on-site, during the Council Meeting or in cases of less than $50 \%$ of all member attendance on-site during the Council meeting via internet as a remote e-voting. A simple majority $(50 \%+1)$ of the Members present during the Council Meeting is required for a valid vote
6. Every member has one vote in the Council or in remote e-voting
